Tuesday, October 1

Wednesday, October 2

8:00AM - 1:00PM and 4:00PM—6:00PM

Day #2 for artists to deliver artwork with completed entry form. **Art will be NOT accepted after 6:00PM deadline.**

Friday, October 4

6:30PM—Concert, 7:30PM—Opening Reception

Exhibition opening reception. Bring your family and friends!

Saturday, October 5—Sunday, October 13

Exhibition is open to the public. Participating artists volunteer as greeters and gallery attendants.

Sunday—Noon to - 5:00PM

Monday—Saturday -11:00 AM—7:00 PM

Monday, October 14

8:00AM—Noon

Participating artists pick up artwork **no later than noon.**
